Once certified this role will assist with maintaining policies, processes, and procedures to ensure continued certification from certifying bodies.

- With limited supervision, prepare various documents as required by Company policy, FAA/EASA regulations, and/or as required by QMS/SMS standards.
- Locate and use appropriate technical data, follow verbal instructions and accept directions from supervisor when accomplishing assigned tasks.
